

MARYLAND STATE ARTS COUNCIL ARTS IN EDUCATION ARTIST SELECTION CONFERENCE

The Maryland State Arts Council's (MSAC) Arts in Education (AiE) Program holds an annual Artist Selection Conference for schools interested in performing arts or visual arts residencies. The Conference provides an opportunity for teachers, cultural arts representatives, and school administrators to meet the performing and visual artists, playwrights, and poets (or their representatives) eligible to participate in the Artists-in-Residence Program.

- **The Artists-in-Residence application deadline for School Year 2011-2012 is May 20, 2011.**
- The guidelines and application forms will be posted on the MSAC website (www.msac.org) prior to the Conference (mid-March)
- A searchable roster of artists is also available on the website, as well as a PDF of the roster.

Residencies provide hands-on intensive workshops involving a core group of students. Larger groups of students can benefit from a residency through artist lectures and demonstrations and through projects developed by classroom teachers with the artist's assistance.

- **Performing Arts** residencies are available in dance, multi-discipline, music, puppetry, and theater.
- **Visual Arts** residencies are available in architecture, ceramics, dollmaking/puppetmaking, fiber arts, glass, handmade paper/books/artist books, media, mixed media, murals, photography, sculpture, site specific installation, and two dimensional.
- **Playwriting** and **Poetry** residencies are also available.
