



Maryland Public Art Commission Executive Committee
Approved Minutes
August 12, 2025, 2:00-3:00 PM

- Chair Judy Kwon called the meeting to order
- The Committee unanimously approved the prior meeting minutes from February 5, 2025, and May 6, 2025
- Program Director Ryan Patterson reported on progress made towards the 2025 Commission and Committee goals.
 - A Nominations Committee has been created and will be chaired by Rebecca Massie Lane.
 - The Program Director has drafted an internal recommendation to revise the MPAI legislation to expand the program's presence in rural communities and to include capital projects on community college campuses as eligible projects. This draft has been submitted internally at Commerce and is awaiting approval or further direction.
- Commission Administration:
 - The Program Director provided a status report on the creation of the new 2026-2028 Public Artist Roster, noting that the project was on track and would be ready for approval at the September Commission Meeting.
 - A schedule and procedure for the Nominations Committee will need to be established.
 - The September Meeting will be held at Frostburg State University to coincide with an artwork dedication. Planning is underway.
