



## Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement

Maryland state regulations require members of deliberative bodies to absent themselves from all discussions and decision-making related to matters for which a conflict of interest exists. For MSAC panelists, a conflict of interest exists if an individual during the past or upcoming 12 months:

- a. was/is actively involved in the governance of an applicant organization (as a member of a board of directors or steering committee),
- b. was/is a paid or unpaid staff member, or
- c. gained/stands to gain financially from the funding of an application under review.

Each MSAC panelist is required annually to identify all organizations with which he or she is currently associated as a member, employee, or board member. This information is kept on file at MSAC offices.
