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Implementation Grant Questions:

1. Grant Request Amount
2. Artist Name and Contact Info
3. Name of the final owner of public artwork
4. Name of who will maintain the artwork
5. Project Description including goals and relevance of the project
6. Project Schedule; Applicant and artist must identify and include in the schedule an Interim Report deadline date at 50% project completion
7. Describe the community engagement process for how the project concept was planned and developed; Include how the artist was selected and the organizations, community groups, and local government agencies that support the proposed project
8. Describe the experience of the applicant organization and selected artist that demonstrates their ability to successfully execute the proposed project
9. Project Budget
10. Project location map
11. Plans and renderings of proposed public artwork that includes dimensions, materials, colors, and finishes; Please upload a PDF file that includes no more than four pages of plans, drawings and/or renderings that fully communicate the proposed public artwork. Please include text to note materials, finishes, and dimensions for the scale.
